Our Story

In 2009, our founder Colleen Gonzalez realized that not all schools could afford a school running program. Schools needed to have enough funds and volunteers to sustain such a program, and many schools lacked these resources.

After establishing a running program and supporting several schools, Colleen established GROW to provide resources for running programs at low-resource schools throughout Seminole County.

Since then, GROW has expanded & supports other grass root efforts that foster children's health and overall well-being.

Cross Country Running

5,019 children ages 5-12 registered to participate in this sport at no cost to their families or their schools

- GROW supported 52 volunteers in 43 schools
- On average, students received 1 hour & 15 minutes additional physical activity beyond normal school hours each week
- Participants had the opportunity to participate in eight running meets that were held on Saturdays between December & February
- GROW makes sure that volunteer coaches have all the durable goods and resources they need for their teams. These include shirts, shoes, and items needed for events.

Community Ball Drive

830 basket, soccer and sports balls were distributed by law enforcement at nine agencies

Inspiring youth to be active over the summer can be a difficult. Families who are economically challenged may lack the means to enroll their youngsters in summer sports programs. To help these families, GROW partnered with every law enforcement agency in Seminole County to distribute sports balls. Neighborhood outreach patrols received over **830** sports balls. This allowed deputies and officers to connect with kids while out on patrol, befriend them, and give them balls for summer fun!



4 play spaces were revitalized

During the 2018-2019 school year, GROW engaged community volunteers to revitalize four spaces for children to play.

Play Space Revitalization

Due to growing student populations, at many playgrounds students face lines to use the large play equipment.

During the 2018-2019 school year, GROW furnished 9 schools with recess toys for such play. Quality recess toys help children to have physically active and enjoyable recess periods. With GROW's support, teachers need not buy such toys themselves, as many had been doing.

416 pairs of shoes were distributed

Each day teachers, social workers and school resource deputies encounter children in need of proper footwear that encourages physical activity.

During the 2018-2019 school year, GROW has supported Grass Root Volunteers who want to exceed expectations and defy odds. Efforts include:

- Providing nutrition and physical activity games for schools, law enforcement agencies or community groups to use and return
- Mentored & supported the Seminole & Lyman High Civic Engagment classes with programming that focused on stress reduction for middle and high school students
- Supported four school based 5k events with needed durable goods resulting in \$38,000 raised for local schools
